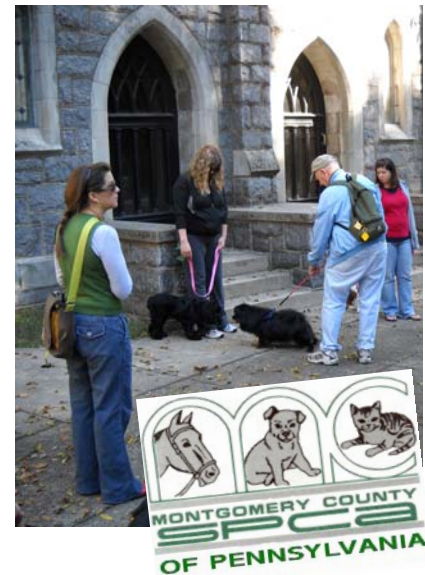
WOOF, WAG N' WALK BENEFITS LOCAL ANIMAL SHELTERS

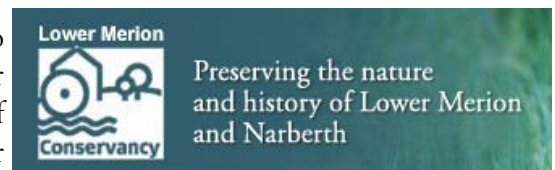
