We continue to perform our essential business activities, providing burial and cremation needs, although occupancy regulations, both indoor and outdoor, remain fluid. Our staff is always available to assist families who wish to purchase burial space in either Laurel Hill or West Laurel Hill if a death has occurred or is imminent. While the number of coronavirus cases in our region continues to ebb and flow, we will always err on the side of caution at our cemeteries and funeral home, as our goal is to continue to ensure the highest level of protection for our staff, families, and visitors while still carrying out our essential roles as a place to bury loved ones and provide solace and relief to the living.
